

## In DeKalb County, Indiana, and Need Your High School Equivalency Diploma?

To prepare for taking the Indiana high school equivalency exam, **previously known as the GED test**, you need to enroll in the Indiana High School Equivalency Exam preparation classes. The preparation classes are designed to prepare you for the high school equivalency exam.

DeKalb County's adult education classes are offered through **Impact Institute**, formerly known as Four County Area Vocational Cooperative. Impact Institute also provides adult education classes in Steuben, Noble, Whitley and LaGrange counties in Indiana. ### What should I know first?

All students must first attend the mandatory orientation prior to attending any Impact Institute adult education classes. These orientation sessions are held at 1607 E. Dowling Street in Kendallville, Indiana. During orientation, you will be given an initial assessment, a broad overview of the Indiana High School Equivalency exam and expectations while you're attending classes. Once you've completed the orientation, you may attend the adult education classes located most conveniently for you.
